Tomorrow's Workshop 2025

The [Food Preservation Workshop] successfully equipped participants with knowledge and hands-on experience in various food preservation techniques. This event emphasized sustainable practices, reducing food waste, and improving self-sufficiency. With an attendance of, the workshop exceeded expectations, garnering positive feedback and high engagement.

Program Highlights
