Understanding Passover

Passover, Easter, or Pesach, is designed by G-d, and presented to us in scripture, as a home-based, family-oriented worship time together at home or at large.

Many parts of the Seder are done in Hebrew, our original language since before the first Passover, and in which almost all the Bible was first written. The Passover meal is called the "Seder" which means the "order." This booklet is called a "Haggadah," which means "the telling."

The key theme of the Seder is the questions and curiosity of children, to which scripture refers and emphasizes (Ex. 12:26, 13:8, 14, Dt. 6:20). The Haggadah is loosely organized around the four cups of wine which even the poorest in the Mediterranean culture could do, and they reflect the fourpart promise "I will . . ." of Ex. 6:6-7. Therefore, say to the children of Israel: 'I am Adonai; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. 'I will take you as my people, and I will be your God.' Yeshua is the sacrificial lamb; through His death, burial, and resurrection the Jews and Gentiles became one BIG family!

"The Standing Prayer"

MODERATOR: This prayer is 2,400 years old and is said three times a day. This is the prayer the disciples were saying in the upper room when Yeshua walked through the walls.

People: You oh Lord, are mighty forever, You revive the dead and You have the power to save. You sustain the living with loving kindness, You revive the dead with great mercy, You support the falling, heal the sick, set free the bound, and keep faith with those who sleep in the dust. Who is like You, oh doer of mighty acts? Who resembles You, a King who puts to death, and restores to life, and causes salvation to flourish? And You are certain to revive the dead. Blessed are You, oh Lord, who revives the dead.

MODERATOR: Just as God commanded the light to shine at creation, let us ask Yeshua to bring light into the dark areas of our life.

All Together: 2 Corinthians 4:5-6 For we don't proclaim ourselves, but Messiah Yeshua as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Yeshua's sake. Seeing It is God who said, "Light will shine out of darkness," who shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Yeshua the Messiah.

Blowing of the Shofar

At Mount Sinai when a resounding shofar was heard, the shofar was speaking of God's voice. We blow the shofar, so we learn to listen for God's voice. Exodus19:16-19 It happened on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunders and lightning, and a thick cloud on the mountain, and the sound of an exceedingly loud shofar; and all the people who were in

the camp trembled. Moses led the people out of the camp to meet God; and they stood at the lower part of the mountain. Mount Sinai, the whole of it, smoked, because the LORD descended on it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly. When the sound of the shofar grew louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by a voice. **All are seated.**

1. THE FIRST CUP - THE CUP OF SANCTIFICATION

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, bo-ray pree ha-gafen .

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, Creator of the fruit of the vine. [All drink the first cup.]

- 2. WASHING HANDS [Everyone washes their hands with water from pitcher over a bowl]
- **3. DIPPING OF PARSLEY IN SALT WATER.** (Pass Seder plate and take a spoon of parsley and dip in salt-water)

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, boray pree ha-a-da-mah.

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, who creates the fruit of the earth. [All eat parsley dipped in salt water.]

- 4. BREAKING THE MIDDLE MATZAH
- **5. RECITE THE HAGGADAH Ma-geed** Passover (Ex. 12:26, 13:8, 14, Deut. 6:20).
- 6. FOUR-Questions Asked by Children:
- #1. Why is this night different from all other nights? On all other nights we eat khametz and Matzah. Tonight, why do we eat only Matzah?
- #2. On all other nights we eat any kind of herbs. Tonight, why do we only eat the bitter herbs?
- #3. On all other nights we do not dip even once. Tonight, why do we dip the greens twice?

#4. On all other nights we eat sitting or reclining. Tonight, why do we all recline?

THE FOUR ANSWERS: #1 Matzah-unleavened bread, #2 The Maror-bitter herbs, #3 We dip Twice, #4 Tonight, we Recline.

7. THE SECOND CUP - THE CUP OF JUDGMENT (refilled after sprinkling of the plagues).

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, bo-ray pree ha-gafen.

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, who creates the fruit of the vine. [All drink second cup.]

8. MATZAH: [Stripes and holes represent the body of Christ]

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, hamo-tsee le-khem meen ha-a-rets.

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth.

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, v'tsee-va-noo at a-khee-lat Matzah.

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, who has commanded us concerning the eating of Matzah. [All eat Matzah]

9. MAROR: [The Maror speaks of the bitterness of sin and its consequences, and the pain of those without a relationship with G-d]

MODERATOR: Ba-rookh atah Adonai, Eh-lo-hay-noo meh-lekh ha-olam, asher keed-sha-noo b'meets-vo-tav v'tsee-va-noo at akhee-lat maror.

People: Blessed are You, Adonai our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with thy commandments, and commanded us concerning the eating of the bitter herbs. [All taste the Maror]
